Notification

No. SEBA/AB/NOTIF/06/2018/64 Dated Guwahati the 26th April, 2024

In continuation of the office Notification No. SEBA/AB/NOTIF/06/2018/62 date 27th February, 2024 and No. SEBA/AB/Notif/06/2018/63 date 12th March, 2024, published in the Academic Calendar, 2024-2025, this is for information of all concerned that some changes regarding Examination under Board of Secondary Education has been decided from the academic session 2024-2025.

- The Board of Secondary Education, Assam has decided to introduce a new elective subject to impart education on "Artificial Intelligence and Robotics" from the academic session 2024-2025 in class IX and from the academic session 2025-2026 in class X. The textbook can be accessed by any of the following ways -
 - The PDF version of the textbook is available in the official website of SEBA (www.sebaonline.org) in the textbook section.
 - The textbook can be also downloaded from the link, <https://teachee.com/artificial-intelligence-a-book-free-for-class-9-10-11-12>
 - Further, the book can also be obtained from the open market.
- The practical marks of all vocational subjects (Artificial Intelligence and Robotics, Garment Designing, Woodcraft, Music, Dance, Yoga and Physical Education, Fine Art, Home Science, Weaving and Textile Design and all subjects under NSQF) shall be 50% from the Academic session 2024-2025.
- The practical marks for Computer Science and Commerce will be 30%, as before.
- The District level Internal Examination Committee will conduct the practical exam for all the subjects i.e. Artificial Intelligence and Robotics, Garment designing, Woodcraft, Music, Dance, Yoga and Physical Education, Computer Science, Commerce, Fine Art, Home Science, Weaving and Textile Design and all the subjects under NSQF for both classes IX and also for Final Board exam of class X, 2025. The system of taking practical Exam at the centre level is abolished. The students must pass in practical examinations separately.
- Students have to secure pass mark in both MCQ and Descriptive Questions separately. 50% of IA marks will be added with the marks secured in MCQ and remaining 50% with the marks secured in Descriptive Questions. In that case pass mark for MCQ portion shall be 13, pass mark for IA in MCQ shall be 2, and similar for Descriptive Question portion also.
- The OMRs will be of four sets i.e. ABCD
- In English and other language subjects, it is not necessary that all the questions will be from the prescribed lessons/chapters only. There may be unseen passages, grammar items, etc. The questions will be based on the learning outcomes of the subjects.
- In the subjects Science and Mathematics, the questions/problems will be concept based which may not be directly from the textbooks. Even questions from examples and references may be included in question papers. In some cases the MCQs may warrant summations/calculations also. The questions will be based on the learning outcomes of the content of the subjects.

- In the subject Social Science, the patterns of questions will also be concept based as per guidelines of NEP 2020. The questions will be based on the learning outcomes of the content of the subjects.
- Patterns of questions of other subjects including the vocational subjects will also be changed as per guidelines of NEP 2020.
- For reference of the teachers as well as students the sample Question Papers as per the guide lines of NEP, 2020 for the subjects Mathematics and Science for class X are uploaded in Board's website. All the Educational institutions will go through the Sample Question Papers for the purpose of imparting Education. The Internal Examiner will follow the pattern of sample Question Papers in the Internal Examinations such as Unit Test, Half yearly and pre-board Exam. The same pattern can be used in the examinations of class IX also. The Questions should not be same as shown in the sample Question Papers, only the pattern should be followed.
- To impart Quality Education, "Teachers' Energize Resource Manual" of the subjects Mathematics and Science will be sent to every school affiliated to SEBA and a training of master trainer shall be provided by SEBA in the month of May, 2024.

All concerned will follow the provisions of this notification scrupulously.
